SHAKEN AGAIN



At least 20 people were injured in Italy's most powerful quake in 36 years.

The earthquake, which measured 6.6 on the Richter magnitude scale, is the fourth to hit the region in recent months. One of these earthquakes, which struck just two months ago, killed nearly 300 people.

When the earthquake struck on Sunday (30 October), more than 3,000 people were forced to leave their homes in central Italy and around 15,000 people were left without electricity.

Italy's Prime Minister, Matteo Renzi, has promised to rebuild all of the homes and churches destroyed by this latest earthquake. "We will rebuild everything. We have the resources to do it," he said.


As *First News* went to press, at least 200 aftershocks had been reported.
