

## HOW TO ACCESS FIRST NEWS ENGAGE

Your school has unlimited access to each week's resources and a full library of previous activities. Simply follow the steps below to get started:



## **Accessing First News Engage as a pupil**

- 1 Visit engage.firstnews.co.uk
- 2 Click 'Login' under 'I am a pupil and I'd like to login'

Your school's First News Education ID can be found in your welcome pack, as well as in the email you received containing details about your package.

- 3 On the next page, click 'I have a class access code' and enter your school's First News Education ID; then click 'Next'
- 4 Select a level from the drop-down menu and click 'Login!'

## Which of the three Engage levels are right for your pupils?

When selecting a level for the first time we suggest you start with 'Level 1 (Beginner)' to get a feel for the articles and activities before moving up to level 2 or 3. However, this is a brief explainer on how our levels are set.

**Level 1 (Beginner):** The news articles are shorter and slightly simpler language is used. Four shorter new activities are published every Monday during term time.

**Level 2 (Intermediate):** These news articles are longer and the activities have more questions to challenge your thinking. Two new activities are published every Monday during term time.

Level 3 (Challenge): The articles and activities are more challenging. More complex news stories may be explored some weeks. Two new activities are published every Monday during term time.

At the end of every activity, pupils can print or save their score card to share with you. Each score card will show students their total words read, the time it took them to complete the activity, the number of points they earned and their accuracy rate. Please note as soon as they navigate away from the activity their points will reset.

We recommend that pupils using Engage print or save the score card to share with the teacher running the class.
